New Features Added

1. **BIOS** update, in the "Available Updates" card on the dashboard. Clicking on "BIOS" in the card filters out the list of devices with outdated BIOS versions. View the current(out-of-date) BIOS version and remedial steps to update it, in the device/issue tray.

Enhancements Done

- 1. Provided toggle button for Quick Remedy filter in the organization settings modal window, enabling admin user to change the default status of the filter.
- 2. Enhanced the capability of the Provisioning tool to install, LDI Plus software agent (Installer Part 2) along with UDC.
- 3. Enhanced the capability of the provisioning script to upgrade the current version of the UDC installed on the device.

Bugs Fixed

- 1. Unsafe shutdown of devices with Universal Device Client (UDC) version 3.1 and earlier.
- 2. Incorrect pointing out to the Lenovo Update Tool for Thunderbolt firmware update, even though the Thunderbolt version installed on the device was up-to-date.
- 3. Display of unrelated options in storage drive filter criteria and irrelevant predicted issues in the potential issues tab.
- 4. Validation failure of the postal code for creation of the service group.
- 5. Button labels, in the "Export with Filters" modal window of the Thunderbolt tab, were not in the title case.
- 6. Failure to register a device to the intended organization.
- 7. Provisioning tool scripting exception that resulted in the display of incorrect error messages while running the provisioning script to onboard the device.

Caveats, Open Issues, and Workarounds

	Issue Description	Severity	Workaround
1	Support Tickets can only be submitted for a particular device once per week.	Minor	None at this time.
2	A device with an expired battery warranty appears in the "Warranty Expiring Soon" list.	Minor	Wait for 24 hours. The device will no longer appear in the "Warranty Expiring Soon" list, after its warranty has expired.
3	The system doesn't display default remediation for "Frequently Crashing" devices.	Minor	None at this time.
4	The remedy provided for battery warranty has a broken link to Lenovo Warranty site.	Minor	None at this time
