New Features and Enhancements

The following features and enhancements have been added in the tool.

- When you click **Download Pack** to download a provisioning package, a green colored loading
 progress bar appears indicating that the download is in progress. Until the download
 completes, the progress bar continues to display, and you can navigate to other modules in
 the meantime.
- Now, you can search for VM and MacOS devices in Device Manager → Devices page in the same way as you do for other devices.

Note: Onboarding Windows devices using InTune will be available soon.

Known Issues

Though the provisioning package appears as installed in the device tray, the folder in the device is empty because the provisioning package is quarantined by the 360 Total Security antivirus. The claimcode.csv file (C:\ProgramData\Lenovo\Udc\privileged) is generated on the local device after install-ldi.bat is run, but the device is not added in the portal.	High	Execute install-ldi.bat again or restart UDC service or reboot the device.	PMP – 14395
While onboarding a virtual machine when you run install-Ldiagent script, it displays an error message.	Low	Execute powershell script again or directly run setup.exe. The package will be installed successfully.	PMP – 15067
